



Dear interested parties we wish to inform you that the European Regulation 2016/679 concerning the protection of natural person regarding Personal Data Processing, as well as the free circulation of such data (from now on "GDPR") provides for the protection of person and other subjects with respect to Personal Data Processing.

Our organization, as Data Controller, pursuant to article 13 of the GDPR, provides the following information:

- **CONTROLLER:** the controller is **DOLOMITI FRUITS Srl**, Italian tax code and V.A.T. registration number **02084480223**, which can be contacted at the phone number **0461 1530070** or at e-mail address **info@dolomitifruits.com**.
- **DATA CATEGORIES:** the controller will treat personal and/or specific data which are strictly necessary for activities included in its core business as well as for activities related to processing and all the other activities envisaged by the corporate purpose and with the obligations of a fiscal nature and other binding laws.
- **SOURCE OF PERSONAL DATA:** the personal data of which the Data Controller will be in possession at the time of execution of the requested work/service/sale.
- **PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING AND LEGAL BASIS:** the processing of your data, collected and stored, has your consent as its legal basis and is carried out for the following purpose: customer and supplier management, internal control and analysis services, product traceability management, sending information, commercial, accounting and tax communications, credit recovery, management of activities related to contractual and mandatory obligations.
- **DATA RECIPIENT:** within the limits pertinent to the indicated processing purposes, your data may be communicated to partners, consultancy firms, consultants, lawyers, companies/institutions, banks, insurance companies, appointed as Data Processors by the Data Controller. Your data will not be disseminated in any way. The Managers and Data Processors in office are duly identified in the Company Data Management Document, updated at least every year end.
- **DATA TRANSFER ABROAD:** the collected data may be transferred outside the European Union only in countries in which an adequacy provision is in force in accordance with applicable standards.
- **DATA RETENTION PERIOD:** the collected data will be kept for a time of period not exceeding the achievement of the purpose for which they are processed ("conservation limitation principle", art 5, GDPR) and/or based on the deadlines set by current regulations and/or based on specific requests. The verification of the obsolescence of the data stored in relation to the purposes for which they were collected is carried out at least every year.
- **RIGHT OF THE INTERESTED PARTY:** the interested party always has the right to request from the Data Controller access to his data, the rectification or cancellation of the same, the limitation of the treatment or the possibility of opposing the treatment, to request the portability of the data, to revoke the consent to the treatment by asserting these and other rights provided for by the GDPR through a simple communication to the Data Controller. The interested party can also lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
- **OBLIGATORY OR NOT OF THE DATA PROVISION:** we inform you that the provision of the requested/acquired data is essential for the fulfilment of the above obligations and their lack of consent to the processing could lead to the non-execution of the contract.
- **AUTOMATED PROCESSES:** the data collected will not be subject to automated processes such as, for example, profiling.
- **DATA PROCESSING METHODS:** the personal data you provide will form the object of processing operations in compliance with the legislation and the confidentiality obligations which inspire the activity of the Data Controller. The data will be processed both with IT tools and on paper and on any other type of suitable support, in compliance with adequate technical and organizational security measures provided for by the GDPR.
